WEDNESDAY 03 SEPTEMBER 2025

As a day trip to be offered to 50+ Club members, we have planned a visit to the BMW MINI Assembly Plant in Oxford, for a tour of the production line. This will take place on Wednesday, 03 September 2025.

The day trip, by coach from the Leisure Centre, will be limited to 30 persons and will cost £41.00 per head to cover coach transport to the BMW plant and later to Oxford City, and the tour of the BMW plant.

We will begin the 100 minute tour with a welcome from the expert BMW Plant guides and an introduction to the plant's rich history and significance. For over a century, cars have been built at this site – now the only place in the UK that builds the MINI, an iconic British car beloved worldwide. Today the plant employs some 3700 associates who manufacture up to 900 MINIS every day and has contributed over 2.25 million MINIs to the tally of over 11.65 million cars that the plant has produced since 1913. Who can forget the original and revolutionary BMC Minis designed by Alec Issigonis, and that became such an icon identified with Swinging London in the 1960s! Feel the heritage come alive as you hear how a humble Oxford factory has evolved into a state-of-the-art facility crafting a very modern version of a true automotive legend. Inside the assembly hall you will be shown the birth of new MINIS as thousands of parts come together on the production line in the build process from the "Body in White" stage, where the car's bare metal shell is welded together, and then

brought to life as parts are seamlessly joined by teams of skilled engineers and robots.

Tours of the plant, which sell out fast, are strictly controlled by BMW and are restricted to tour parties of 15 people each. We have managed to book **two tour groups for a total of 30 people** with the tours starting at 12.20 pm on Wednesday 03 September 2025.

BMW have a number of instructions for visitors to the plant, and these are attached, as Page 3, for your guidance. Please make sure you read them.

There are no refreshment facilities, such as a café, for guests at the plant, so after the tours are finished, we plan to go on to the centre of Oxford to enable passengers to be dropped off to find a late lunch or tea and/or have some time to explore the centre of Oxford before we return to Woking.

Pick up from the designated pick-up point in Oxford for the return coach journey to Woking will be at 4.30pm and we expect to arrive back at the Leisure Centre at 6.30 pm or shortly before this time.

As this day trip is limited to 30 people we recommend that you book promptly to secure your place. Bookings will be taken on a first come, first paid basis. GUIDANCE NOTES FOR VISITOR GROUPS COMING ON GUIDED TOURS OF THE PLANT

- 1) Not recommended for people with heart problems or other serious medical conditions.
- 2) Visitors should have a moderate physical fitness level. This is a walking tour and a certain level of mobility is required to cover the distance around the site.
- 3) Please note that electromagnetic radiation is used in one of our assembly halls, which may affect the function of medical devices such as insulin pumps, or pacemakers and could pose a risk for pregnant people.
- 4) Closed -toed shoes must be worn during the tour. Long sleeve clothing is recommended for the tour due to sparks.
- 5) For a full tour experience, visitors are provided with audio guides and headphones. Wearing headphones is compulsory.
 If you have a medical condition that prevents you from wearing headphones, please advise your tour Co- Ordinator promptly so that he can contact the BMW Booking Centre for further information prior to your visit
- 6) Assistive listening technology can be provided for individuals with reduced ranges of hearing (Inductive Neck Loops) Please advise us in advance of any such requirements
- 7 Current global events can have a significant impact on our vehicle production. As a result, tours may have to be cancelled for operational reasons. Should this happen, we will offer alternative dates as soon as possible.
- 8) Please be prepared to provide valid identification, if requested, as your group has booked a special concession tour 65 years plus
- 9) The Visitor Centre opens 30minutes before the start of the tour. While you are waiting, you can join our museum tour and take photographs of our historic exhibits. However, the use of cameras and mobile phones for taking pictures inside the plant during the plant tour is not permitted
