Norfolk

With Woking Leisure Centre 50+ Club 6/9 June 2024

Norfolk is a fascinating county full of historic cities and tranquil coastal views. Around every corner you will find quaint villages, stately homes and sprawling countryside. Our tour takes us to the classic highlights and hidden gems of the county including a step back in time at a royal station, exploring a rural farmhouse still in operation today and enjoying the sights and sounds of a coastal steam train ride.

Thursday 6 June - Moyse's Hall Museum and Abbey

We start our tour by joining the coach at Woking Leisure Centre in the morning. Our first stop is the historic market town of Bury St Edmunds, where there are many options for exploring and for lunch at leisure. Following this, we make our way to Moyse's Hall Museum and Abbey. The museum offers an insight into the past of Bury St Edmunds, documenting the foundation of the town, the creation and dissolution of the abbey and the views, superstitions and beliefs popular in the past. After our visit we continue to the Holiday Inn Norwich North, our base for the tour.

Friday 7 June - Sandringham Estate and Wolferton Royal Station

Today we visit the iconic Sandringham Estate. Built for Edward VII, Sandringham has passed through generations of royals and remains in high esteem to this day, with its sprawling lawns and gardens, coach house museum spaces displaying vintage royal vehicles, and stately home containing collections of artwork, silver, porcelain and enamel pieces. Following our visit we make the short journey over to Wolferton Royal Station. The station became famous in the 1800s as due to its proximity to Sandringham the royal family made frequent use of it, with additions being made to the station such as space to house the royal coaches and and a suite of reception and retiring rooms. No longer in use, today the station stands still in time as a testament to its working days, and visitors can explore the platform, grounds and workshop.

Saturday 8 June - Gressenhall Farm and Workhouse and North Norfolk Railway

This morning we travel to Gressenhall Farm and Workhouse. Visitors can discover the rich rural history of farming life in Norfolk through a variety of projections, archives and collections. The Workhouse Trail tour will provide a unique insight into the history of the workhouse and the people who lived there. There is also a trailer ride around the working farmland providing great views of the grounds and all the animals that live there. In the afternoon we travel to Holt for a trip on the North Norfolk Railway to Sheringham. The stations have been restored to their original country station appearances, with each being themed to a different decade in the railway's past.

Sunday 9 June - Walking tour of Norwich and Woodforde's Brewery

Today we check out of the hotel and make our way to Norwich city centre for a guided walking tour. Our experienced guide takes us around the highlights of this impressive and historic city, from the Art Deco city hall building to the extensive Norwich Market, one of the country's oldest and most extensive outdoor marketplaces, and the impressive and ancient Cathedral Quarter. After our tour concludes we visit Woodforde's Brewery, where we enjoy a tour of their brewing operation with the chance to sample some of their wares in the adjoining bar. Following this we say farewell to Norfolk and depart for our homeward journey back to Woking.
